CAMP ALEXANDER MACK



Camp Alexander Mack is a Christian camp, conference, and retreat center located on more than 200 acres along the shore of Lake Waubee in Milford.

The facilities include four rustic, well maintained, winterized, and accessible lodges providing lodging and meeting spaces for groups of 8 to 200 people. The summer camp includes the lodges plus cabins serving up to 425. A Quiet Place, a personal retreat and prayer center, will accommodate up to five persons for personal retreats, solitude, and spiritual direction. The auditorium will accommodate up to 1,500 people. Also available are outdoor settings for church worship and baptism.

Recreational activities onsite include hiking, sailing, canoeing, boating, swimming, fishing, sand volleyball, basketball, softball, soccer, ropes course, ping pong, climbing towers, a challenge course and more.

Enjoy an inspiring hike to "The Living Cross", a white oak tree which has grown into the shape of a cross. Take a tranquil walk through our wilderness where wildlife surprises you at every turn!
